Bible Quiz

Purpose

To challenge students to achieve a knowledge of God's Word.

Grade Levels

There are three grade levels in this event: K, 1, 2.

Process:

- Bible Quiz Coaches should read and understand the rules for the current year.
- Each participating congregation is responsible for providing one proctor for the Bible Quiz event.

Pre-Event

- The subject of the 2018 Bible Quiz will be the Book of 1 Samuel and chapters 1-15.
- Questions will be drawn from the text of the New International Version (2011)
- Check www.seltc.org for Bible Quiz study materials and website links

Event

- Participant requirements
 - To participate, each congregation must provide one proctor.
 - Participants should participate at their own grade level.
 - Participants should report to the event area 15 minutes before the scheduled start time.
 - Participants may have no outside materials on their tables during the event.
 - Participants may not have cell phones in their possession.
 - Participants are allowed to leave the room only in case of an emergency and must be accompanied by their team's proctor.
- Proctor Requirements
 - The Proctor will sign-in participants from their congregation into the event.
 - Proctors will be responsible for their congregation's participants while in the room and once the event is completed.
 - Proctors will be required to sign each participant from their congregation out of the room before the participant can leave the room.
- Spectator Requirements
 - Spectators may not enter or leave the room while the event is in process.
 - Spectators are allowed no speaking privileges during the event.
- Questions and Answers
 - \circ $\,$ All questions will be objective, calling for specific facts or order of events.
 - No question will call for an interpretation.
 - A Scripture reference will accompany each question.
 - If the answer is heard spoken by anyone in the room, the question will be voided and credit for that question will be given to all participants.
 - The questions will be multiple choice with 3 choices given for each question.
- Quiz

- The quiz will feature two rounds of written questions, each round consisting of 20 questions.
- The quiz will be provided to each proctor for distribution.
- Each question will be displayed on a screen.
- The proctor will read each question twice.
- After the second time, the participants will have 10 seconds to mark their answer.
- At the end of each round, the participants will have an additional 3 minutes to review the quiz.
- $\circ~$ At the end of round one there will be a 5 minute break.
- Participants will not be allowed to leave the room during the break without their proctor.

Awards

- Awards are determined by the cumulative score of each individual compared to the highest individual score in that grade level. (See the scoring table.)
- The Gold Award goes to individuals scoring within 90%
- The Silver Award goes to individuals scoring from 80 89.9%
- The Bronze Award goes to individuals scoring from 70 79.9%
- The Participant Award goes to individuals scoring below 70%
