Modern Drama

Purpose

To encourage students to dramatize modern-day life applications of Christian truths.

Grade Levels

There are three grade levels in this event: 3-6, 7-8, 9-12.

(K-2 may participate with a higher grade level team, as long as the majority of the team is grade 3 or higher.)

Process:

- Select an appropriate modern-day application drama of the current year's theme.
- Provide costumes, props, and lighting if desired.
- Drama participants may perform in no more than two dramas.
- Students may participate in a higher age division but not in one below their grade level.
- Each congregation should register no more than four drama teams per age group.

Team Event

- Print out Team Sheet from on-line registration portal
- Turn in Team Sheet when the team checks in at the event

Rules

- The drama is a modern-day application of any Christian truth with respect to the current year's theme. This is not a Bible story reenactment.
- The drama presentation should be between six and ten minutes. The maximum time includes setting up, performing and exiting the stage area.
- Adults may help in set-up and break-down of props. Adults should be clear of the stage area during the performance.
- All CD players and special lighting must be powered by battery; no plug-ins will be allowed.
- The room regular lighting may not be lowered or blacked out for performance.
- No fireworks are allowed.
- Stages / Performance areas may vary in size. Be prepared to adapt.
- Drama teams need to arrive at least 15 minutes before performance.
- Spectators may enter or exit the room at designated times between performances.
- All participants will be pre-registered by their churches, and placed in a specific room. If a participant's name is not on the list or other changes need to be made, see the event coordinator for resolution.

Awards

There are three ratings available in each grade level – Gold, Silver or Bronze.

The drama will be judged in the level of the oldest participant.
