Puppets

Purpose

To encourage the presentation of Biblical stories through the use of puppets.

Grade Levels

There are four grade levels in this event: 3-4, 5-6, 7-8, 9-12.

(K-2 may participate with a higher grade level team, as long as the majority of the team is grade 3 or higher.)

Process:

- Select appropriate puppet script related to the current year's theme.
- Students may participate in a higher age division but not in one below their grade level.
- Each congregation should register no more than four puppet teams per age group.

Team Event

- Print out Team Sheet from on-line registration portal
- Turn in Team Sheet when the team checks in at the event

Rules

- Each team will have ten minutes to set up, perform and exit the stage area.
- Each team will enter with props and puppets after they are announced. Timing will begin when teams are announced and will stop when puppeteers have cleared the stage.
- Adults may help in set-up and break-down of props. Adults should be clear of the stage area during the performance.
- Puppet stages are provided. They are four feet in height, twelve feet in width, and three feet in depth. If another stage is to be used, the break-down and set-up will be included in the ten-minute time limit. Diagrams of the stage are available at www.seltc.org.
- Each team must provide their own props. Because of audience sizes, chairs may not be available for puppeteers.
- Each play is presented live. Tape recording of special effects is allowed, but tape recording of dialogue is not allowed.
- CD players and lights need to be run by battery.
- No fireworks are allowed.
- All forms of puppetry are acceptable, i.e. marionettes, karaoke, etc.
- Puppet teams need to arrive at least 15 minutes before performance.
- Spectators may enter or exit the room at designated times between performances.
- All participants will be pre-registered by their churches, and placed in a specific room. If a team is not on the list or other changes need to be made, see the event coordinator for resolution.

Awards

There are three ratings available in each grade level – Gold, Silver or Bronze.

The puppet team will be judged in the level of the oldest participant
