Video Bible Drama

Purpose

To dramatize, through a video project, a Bible story or modern day application which illustrates the current year's theme, using student actors with appropriate costumes and props.

Grade Levels - There are five grade levels in this event: K-2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-8, 9-12.

Process

- Each participating congregation will: Select an appropriate story that illustrates the current year's theme or a passage from the current book(s) of study.
 - Create the script based on the scripture.
 - Provide costumes, props, and student actors.
 - Videotape the play.
 - Provide a script and a website link to the edited video.
 - The videos can be uploaded to YouTube, or Vimeo on an individual's account.
- Provide a website link and email it to seltc.office@gmail.com.
 - The email should have the subject line "Video Bible Drama."
 - The completed Pre-Convention form should be attached to the email as a PDF
 - A team sheet should be downloaded from the registration portal (reg.seltc.org) and sent as a PDF
 - Attach a PDF of the script
- All materials should be sent to SELTC by the pre-convention deadline.
- The video will be judged and returned if necessary, along with judges' sheets, to the students at the convention.

Rules

- The Bible Drama stories are to be selected from either the Old or New Testament; they may be a re-telling of a biblical story or a modern-day application.
- The Bible Drama should illustrate the current years' theme.
- Maximum length of the drama is 10 minutes.
- Participating groups may submit more than 1 entry, but each drama submitted must be recorded and submitted separately with a separate Pre-Convention form attached.
- The drama may include students from more than 1 grade level

Awards

There are 3 ratings available in each grade level – Gold, Silver or Bronze.

The Bible drama will be judged in the level of the oldest participant.
