Website Design

Purpose

To give young people the opportunity to develop and demonstrate their creative and technical talents by the creation of a web site on the Internet. The site may be for their congregation or their youth group and must glorify God and represent the current year's LTC theme.

Grade Levels

There are four grade levels for this event: 3-4, 5-6, 7-8, 9-12.

Process

- Teams or individuals from a congregation will:
 - Create a web site on the Internet.
 - Complete a Pre-Convention form (in the Forms Section)
 - If more than 1 student works on the Website, print out a Team Sheet from the registration portal. (reg.seltc.org)
- This event may be submitted by email or mailing.
- To submit by email – email the link to seltc.office@gmail.com.
 - The email should have the subject line "Website Design."
 - The completed Pre-Convention form should be attached to the email as a PDF
 - A team sheet should be downloaded from the registration portal (reg.seltc.org) and sent as a PDF
- To submit by mail, send the following to the SELTC Office.
 - Include a completed Pre-Convention form
 - Download a Team Sheet from the registration portal (reg.seltc.org) and attach it to the Pre-Convention form.
- All information should be sent to SELTC by the pre-convention deadline.
- Judges' sheets will be provided to the students at the convention.

Rules

- The format of the site should be generally accessible to most users of the Internet.
- Each site may consist of one or more pages with links from the site to the individual pages.
- Sites may be linked, but the participant must specify exactly which URL's are to be judged.
- Adult assistance should be limited to that of advice and supervision.
- An unlimited number of teams and/or participants from each congregation are allowed per grade level with a maximum of 5 students per team. One team of students may only work on 1 entry.

Awards

There are 3 ratings available in each grade level – Gold, Silver or Bronze.

The website will be judged in the level of the oldest participant.
